Introduce Yourself:

Start with a handshake and smile :)

- Name
- Grade
- Agilities/interests – give them something to talk to you about!

Example:

Hi! I'm Samantha and I'm a sophomore. I'm in robotics and love my math classes because I really enjoy working with information and innovating. Can you tell me how those skills are used in different jobs in your company?

Additional Questions

Keep the conversation going

- What is your current job title?
- How did you get the position you have today?
- What's been your career journey?
- What advice would you give high schoolers to prepare for their future?
- Which Agilities do you use most in your current career?
- What does your company do?
- What positions in your company use (your top Agility)?
- What's the best piece of advice you've ever gotten?

End a Conversation

Keep conversations short & informational

END CONVERSATION WHEN: Lull in conversation or other people are waiting to talk to them.

- Thank them
- Mention something from conversation
- It was great meeting you
- Connect on LinkedIn

Example:

Thank you so much for talking to me today, it was really cool learning about the consulting positions at Deloitte that use developing others! It was really great meeting you, can I connect with you on LinkedIn?
